TOP TIP

- Don't be afraid to combine different shades of white and cream, it creates visual interest through subtle contrast while amplifying natural light. The Resene whites and neutrals collection has up to six strength variations of the most popular whites and creams to make it easy for you to mix and match.
- When pairing white and cream tones, opt for warm whites rather than cool whites. Creams add a soft glow to a room when teamed with warm whites but can look murky against cool whites.



Pale and interesting is also peaceful and uplifting when you layer milky whites with cream and caramel tones.

Try continuing your Resene wall colour onto the ceiling or floor for a more cocooning effect. Luxurious tonal looks can be created by layering one colour family. Evolve this by mixing and matching Resene colours that have similar undertones for added depth. Pair Resene Tea walls with a Resene Blanc floor, upcycle your existing furniture by repainting
